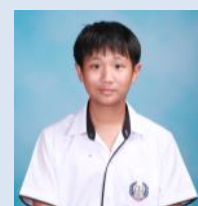

Every year St. Mark's International School students from Year 3 through Secondary participate in the ISA (International Schools' Assessment), a set of tests used globally by international schools to monitor student performance. We are pleased to announce our students' achievement in the recent ISA administered in February of 2017.

In **Mathematical Literacy**, Netanya Pisutboriboon (Year 3) ranked in the top 5 percent among all participants. Thien Buathong (Year 7) achieved outstanding results which put him in the top 5 percent of all participants. Aaron Sirisambhand and Thananchai Ruangmethanon (Year 8) also obtained remarkable scores placing their names on the top 1 percent. Their results were far above the OECD average (2012) for students at the 15 year-old level.

In **Reading**, Xyren Lucas (Year 3) ranked in the top 1 percent among all participants. Cleojai Ruangmethanon (Year 3) also achieved a high score ranking in the top 10 percent. In Year 8, Aaron Sirisambhand received a remarkable result ranking in the top 1 percent and Thananchai Ruangmethanon ranked in the top 5 percent.
